

Regarding the 10 Commandments, the emphasis is on "the Sabbath...a perpetual Covenant". Because once sin is resolved there will be no need to emphasize the other nine. (See Isa. 66:22-23) It is "a sign" between God and His people "for ever" (Exo. 31:17), "blessed [&] sanctified" (Gen. 2:3).

The Type Covenant—the Sanctuary Service ("the first old", Heb. 8:13)

-the blood of goats and calves, and carnal ordinances can never "make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience" (9:9). This aspect of the "old" is what vanished.

The need for a Mediator remained.

The "New Covenant"

Mediatorial Covenant –

The New Covenant is Christ's High Priestly Ministration in the Heavenly Sanctuary. This Ministry "by his own blood", "precious blood", and "surety of a better covenant", provided what the "old" could not "as pertaining to the conscience".

"For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people". ▲(Heb. 8:10; 10:16)

The common misunderstanding in Christianity is the misapplied concept concerning the Bible's Covenants. The common assumption is that the "old" Covenant concerns the 10 Commandments. The Bible does not so state. The Ten Commandments are not the "old" Covenant that vanished away. Paul explained, what vanished away related only to the Sanctuary Services that "could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience." (Heb. 9:9) By misunderstanding the Bible Covenants – Mainstream Christianity is therefore left without a Great High Priest as a Mediator of the "new covenant" – which includes His Ten Commandments.
