

"Then I heard one saint speaking, and another saint said unto that certain [Palmowniy — Wonderful Numberer] saint which spake, How long ["until when?] shall be the [1] vision concerning the daily, [2] and the transgression of desolation, to give both the sanctuary and the host to be trodden under foot? And he said unto me, Unto two thousand and three hundred days; then shall the sanctuary be cleansed." (Dan. 8:13-14, ea.)

The "taken away" implies the "daily" was obscured in the minds of men. And in 1844 it is restored as the perfect sacrifice for the continuation of the "Everlasting Gospel" – "It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these." (Heb. 9:23)
