

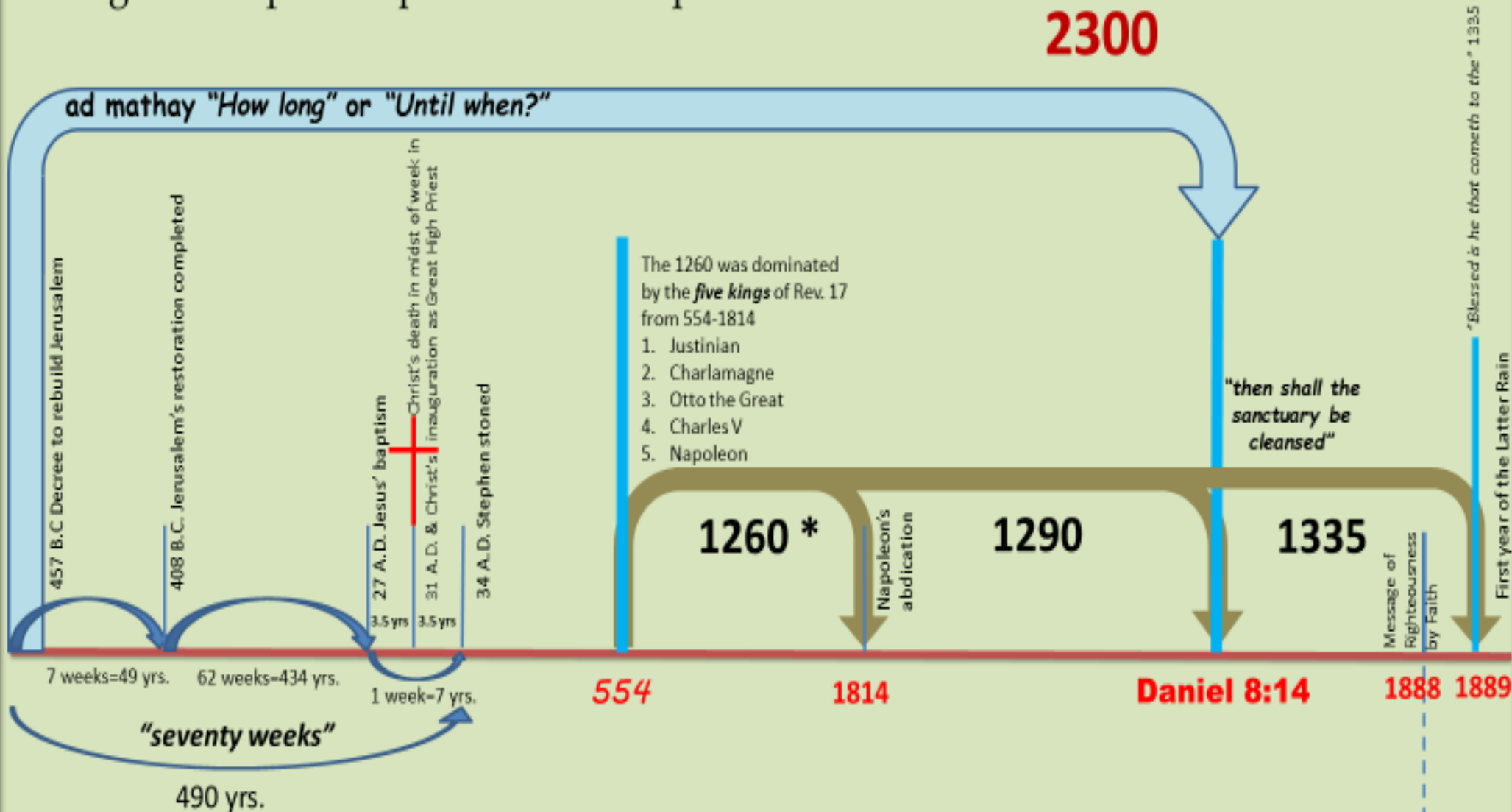
And from the time that the daily shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, there shall be a thousand two hundred and ninety days.

Daniel 12:11

*"Then I heard one saint speaking, and another saint said unto that certain [Palmowniy – Wonderful Numberer] saint which spake, How long ["until when?"] shall be the [1] vision concerning the daily, [2] and the transgression of desolation, to give both the sanctuary and the host to be trodden under foot? And he said unto me, Unto two thousand and three hundred days; then shall the sanctuary be cleansed." (Dan. 8:13-14, ea.)*

The "taken away" implies the "daily" was obscured in the minds of men. And in 1844 it is restored as the perfect sacrifice for the continuation of the "Everlasting Gospel" – "It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these." (Heb. 9:23)

# Letting the Scriptures speak – Time Prophecies of Daniel



\* Footnote: From the end of the 1260, a 30-year extension equals 1290. And a 45-year extension from 1290 equals 1335; so that we will not think that there are three long periods of time. Each of the 3 prophetic periods have the same starting date as explained in Scripture. (Dan. 12:6-7, 11-13)

1888 was the dividing line between the early rain & the latter rain
