Its relationship to Biblical history
Its influence upon Laodicea and the Apocalypse

Part 1

What is Noosphere? Does noosphere hold a 'mystical influence' that coincides Jesus' end time prophecy in Matt 24:15 which He called the Abomination of Desolation and its kindred forewarning, the First Angels warning of Rev 14?

Answer - Yes.

This discussion sets out according to the Bible the history of noosphere in its many subtle formations unto its ultimate development of Revelation 13 and the Miracle Working False Prophet in discussion Part 4.

NOOSPHERE = the Omega Point = end point = Christ Consciousness, = Unity Consciousness = Hive Mind = Spiralling = Singularity = Nirvana.

What is the Noosphere and its connection to Biblical history?

It was a term which was developed by a French Jesuit priest whose name was **Pierre Teilhard de Cardin**. <u>Here</u>

"For de Chardin, the noosphere emerges through and is constituted by the interaction of human minds. The noosphere has grown in step with the organization of the human mass in relation to itself as it populates the Earth. As mankind organizes itself in more complex social networks, the higher the noosphere will grow in awareness. This concept extends Teilhard's Law of Complexity/Consciousness, the describing the nature of evolution in the universe. Teilhard argued the noosphere is growing towards an even greater integration and unification, culminating in the Omega Point - an apex of thought/consciousness which he saw as the goal of history."

His ideas according to the times which he lived appeared to be a radical departure from Catholic Church doctrine.

The Omega Point is an ...

event in which the entirety of the <u>universe</u> spirals toward a final point of <u>unification</u>. The term was invented by the French <u>Jesuit</u> Catholic <u>priest Pierre Teilhard de Chardin</u> (1881–1955). [1] Teilhard argued that the Omega Point resembles the Christian <u>Logos</u>, namely <u>Christ</u>, who draws all things into himself, who in the words of the <u>Nicene Creed</u>, is "God from God", "Light from Light", "True God from True God", and "through him all things were made". [2] In the <u>Book of Revelation</u>, Christ describes himself thrice as "the <u>Alpha and the Omega</u>, the beginning and the end".

But when one analyses the story of his particular order being that of the Jesuits; it should come as no surprise, at all, especially to his comrades within the order, as well as outside of the order, considering the fact that the Church of Rome has <u>all</u> the **theological tools** necessary for what appears to be a radical departure from Christianity.

Some of the theological tools are as follows: -

- Monasticism which is derived from ascetic practices of the Gnostics in order to close the mind to the world of empirical content
- 2. **Contemplation** or centred prayer Meditation whose goal is to achieve 'unity with the universe' is totally different from regular prayer which is directed to the Father in heaven in the name of Jesus

3. **Unity Consciousness** spiritualism or mysticism as evidenced by St. Theresa of Avila and St. John of the Cross. These two saints of the Roman church are prime example of supposed unity of the mind with the Universe here which they claimed to have experienced in the form of what appears to be a timeless black **void**.

Yet, the church persecuted the <u>Alumbrados</u> that practiced the same thing. Fact is, that neither Teresa of Avila nor St. John of the Cross saw God - since according to <u>1 Timothy 6:16</u>, no one has seen God.

1 Timothy 6:16

¹⁶ Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen.

No one has seen God especially by way of spiritual exercises.

It appears that Timothy was being instructed by Paul **against** Gnostic teachers who were saying that you don't need faith, that once you achieve "Unity Consciousness" you become one with God.

It is precisely this point that the Mystics and Unity consciousness advocates all believe that they can achieve <u>oneness</u> with God. Some will call him the Universe.

4. The **Creeds of both the Eastern and Western** churches feature
Christ as "Begotten not Created prior to the ages" and this runs contrary to John 1:1 and also contrary to Romans 1:3 and what Jesus stated about himself as being the Alpha and the Omega = Rev 22:13,16.

Emanated Logos

Emanated Logos = Christ being "birthed" as a **Thought** or emanation from the Father and he in turn created the material world?

Believing in an emanated Logos prepares the way for the <u>Secret Doctrine of the Occult</u> which is <u>soul cycling</u> in the form of emanations from the so-called one consciousness of the Universe which can either return to the 'original source of Consciousness' - supposedly by way of the process of Life death and rebirth, which includes self-judgement of Karma, or by way of asceticism and punishment of the flesh.

The Apostle Paul stated that both were **useless** in combating fleshy lusts.

As one can see, there is no difference between the Hindu mystic punishing his body or the Catholic Penitent crucifying himself during Holy week. It's a way of obtaining merit.

John 1:1

John 1:1 does not present the concept of an emanated Logos. One should see immediately that John 1:1 clearly states that the Word was in Beginning and alongside God and was God.

Whereas the Nicene Creed states the **OPPOSITE**:

NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father;

through him all things were made.
For us men and for our salvation
he came down from heaven,
and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of
the Virgin Mary, and became man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried,

and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church.
I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come.

Amen.

Fundamental objectives of creedal belief.

Many years ago, there was a family friend, who was Catholic and at times we had talks, yet I could never explain to him that the fundamental doctrine of his church creed, would one day provide the basis for the teaching of the Jesuit Father Pierre Teilhard.

Jose stated from time to time that some within the organization were saying that there will come a time when the Catholic religion would be overhauled and turned into another religion. Being a 7th Day Adventist at the time, I knew a lot about Rome, but I never realized that the specific seeds for this change, actually resides **within** their own Creed, as well as that of the Orthodox Church.

Fact is that 7th Day Adventists get bogged down on the Sunday law matter and fail to recognise two things

1) they adopted the intrinsic formulation of the Nicene Creed as <u>FB #2,4</u> in statement of Beliefs, and 2) that the concept of the Noosphere and its concept of One Consciousness will be the basis for the Mark of the Beast.

And worse, the two schools of Laodicean theology, sustain the attack on the First Angel warning A) the papal Trinty and the B) Arian version via Waggoner & Jones.

And being as bogged down as they are with the NSL, means they have no reason to grasp why they are brooking the ongoing attack upon the First Angel warning, which will come in to

furtherance of the unity of the "one god" "Super consciousness concept".

This is already present in reference to a wrong interpretation of the text within the Shema of <u>Deuteronomy 6:4</u> and will be placed on the right hand and forehead as seen in <u>Deuteronomy 6:8</u> and <u>Revelation 13.</u>

What is the True Shema?

True Shema

Whereas, the true Shema explanation, requires a proper understanding of the original Two Divines as depicted in Psalm 110:1-4 and John 1:1 as well as Genesis 1:26. And also, the words for one which are **Echad** which = oneness in two or more; and <u>Yachid</u> which = one singular being. The Shema utilizes the word Echad since Elohim is a plural word which translates as Gods.

Elohim = plural word for God = Gods - are in fact Two Independent Singular Beings which are one in purpose, love and accord. What is required in this matter about Noosphere and such is a right understanding of the word Elohim which is plural, but according to modern Rabbinic Judaism it means one singular entity.

This point must not be forgotten.

Alpha & Omega of deadly heresies

The same problem arose within the 7th Day Adventist Church in which their own messenger EGW spoke about a coming change which she referred to as the "Alpha and Omega of deadly heresy" which would be received by the denomination in what she termed a "New Movement."

And "Nothing would stop it."

NOOSPHERE = the Omega Point = end point = Christ Consciousness, = Unity Consciousness = Hive Mind = Spiralling = Singularity = Nirvana.

In order to sum up the matter of how the **NOOSPHERE**, which was coined by Pierre Teilhard de Chardin **and** the Alpha and Omega of deadly heresy, is that it was referred to by EGW as - one in the same thing.

We first have to study this concept which has different terms.

The first being <u>Unity Consciousness</u>, the second being a <u>Hive mind</u>, the third absorption into the Divine = <u>Nirvana</u>.

There was an original heresy in the early Christian church which provided the fundamental basis of this Noosphere concept.

Which in reality is that all the minds of planet earth will one day reach <u>a</u> <u>consensus of unity</u> in the form of a so-

called oneness of spirituality as well as social cohesion and there is a third term which applies to Computers which is referred to as Singularity.
