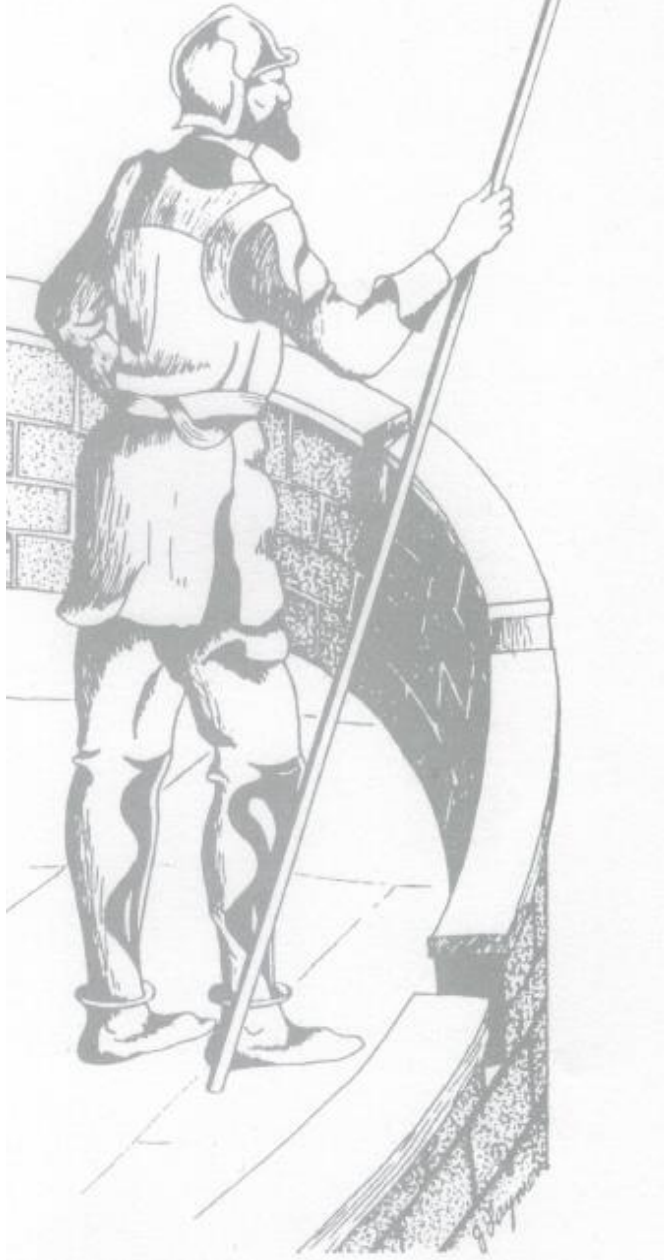

For many this discussion would at first instance be a strange subject to even be bothered, let alone to discuss. It should not be so considered because there is a specific [HADITH](#) in Islamic eschatology that needs a discussion in connection to Matt 24.

A HADITH is the Arabic word for a report or an account (of an event). For the reason the [DAJJAL](#) = false messiah is well known in Islamic theology who is an evil lying individual and is defeated by [Isa Ibn Maryam](#) = Prophet Jesus.

Islam say - Jesus the son of Mary, defeats the Dajjal. The AC.

Hadith - Prophet Jesus

A [HADITH](#) is an account of a theological narrative in relation to religious tradition of Islam - but not found in the Quran. The Prophet Jesus in Islam = [Isa Ibn Maryam](#). And ISA IBN MARYAM is the son of Mary. Mary is revered in Islam – [here](#).

The Quran describes Jesus as the Messiah which means Jesus the son of Mary is well recognised in Islamic theology. The hadiths say **Isa Ibn Maryam** will defeat the Dajjal at the Second Coming – [here](#). The son of Maryam is recognised as the Promised Messiah. Orthodox Islam recognises the virgin birth.

So, what's with Jesus being requited in Islamic Eschatology? Yes, but many will read to here and conclude, what a waste of time. But is it?

The First Angels warning of Rev 14:7 encompasses the earth and relates to the Loud Cry. Rev 18. Does the HADITH about ISA IBN MARYAM relate to Daniel and Revelation? Yes! They too are sought by HWM to know what is truth especially in respect to John 1 and the First Angels warning.

The HADITH of the Dajjal involves the **King of the South** = Islam. Daniel said the clash of the King of the South and the King of the North = [Dan 11:40-45](#) is

significant and that these two powers relate to events = WW3 just prior to the scarlet woman and her "great city" being destroyed = Rev 17:16-18. And the emergence of the AC or the DAJJAL. They are a people who are to be made aware of the First Angels warning and the 7N. See James 2:19 presentation [here](#)

Who kills the Dajjal

Islam advise the [Dajjal](#) is an evil figure who pretends to be the promised Messiah.

The hadiths say the Dajjal melts like salt. Then they say Japheth is behind them. This sounds like 2THESS2 and opposite of Zach 8:23.

Paul warns in 2 Thes 2 of a false Messianic figure ...

² That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

³ Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that **man of sin be revealed**, the son of perdition;

⁴ Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in

the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.

⁵ Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?

⁶ And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.

⁷ For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way.

⁸ And then shall that **Wicked be revealed**, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming ⁹ Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, ¹⁰ And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

¹¹ And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: ¹² That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

Islam holds a theological view that aligns with 2THES2 as do the major monotheistic traditions. Fact is, the major monotheistic religions all refuse to accept Christ's Eternal Identity as Equal to God = John 1. That is a major problem

since it doesn't agree with the Two Divines of John 1:1.

The Bible evidence states there were Two Divine in beginning = John 1 = Rev 22:13,16 = I Am = Jn 8:58 & Exodus 3 = Alpha Identity = LSFOTW Alpha Identity = ERxF of Rev 13:8.

The three major monotheist religions – Judaism, Islam and Roman Catholicism hold tenets that dissipate or deny Christ's eternal Alpha Identity as stated in John 1. So, does it mean they will be deceived by the AC? Have to say – indeed, it will be the case. See the three warnings about false Christs in Matt 24. But what is the sticky subject that makes this a reality? The Shema, the Shahada and Nicene.

Shema, Shahada, Nicene

The three major tenets of monotheism are the Nicene, the Shema and the Shahada. Yes, they all convey in their respective narratives - there is only ONE GOD.

So, what are you to make of John 1:1 and Mark 12?

Jesus met with the Scribes in Mark 12, and for many this chapter 'dials-in' the One God Shema of Deut 6:4 and no arguments from the Nicene. Islam agrees with the emphasis of One God - the [Shahada](#).

For RCC it's the Nicene Creed. For Laodicea its FB #2,4 that replicates monotheism in its grandest order. Don't forget, Laodicea adopted the central doctrine of the scarlet woman = RCC and note what is said in [Rev 3:16](#).

It's worth now to consider the Shahada and Shema and Nicene credos Mark 12 in light of why Jesus said He was Alpha and Omega. Rev 22:13,16.

Mark 12

²⁸ And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all?

²⁹ And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

³⁰ And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.

³¹ And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

³² And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for

there is one God; and there is none other but he: ³³ And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.

How do you reconcile Mk 12:29 with John 1?

For the simple fact - John 1 is the true Shema of the New Testament.

¹ In beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

There have been prior discussions about Deut 6:4 and why the translation of only One God should recognise Two Divines in the Hebrew.

What is also very clear, the limits of monotheism are countered by the First Angels warning to fear God and to worship HWM and worship is due unto only to True Divinity. The First Angel testifies of Two Divines. As stated in John 1.

The three major monotheistic powers base their legitimacy upon the One God— but nevertheless - all have a problem with John 1 and ERxF. Is this the main reason

Jesus warned in Matt 24 of false Christs?
Who will come in His name?

What rancour's the orthodoxy of the three major monotheist religions is the denial of One God and for that they invoke the charges of blasphemy, just as Caiaphas did in Matt 26.

Shahada controversy

The controversy of Walid Shoebat with the Shahada in the above link, who claims it's the mark of the Islamic anti-Christ and resembles the Greek script. Heiser says no.

Becomes very clear the Shahada is the same resemblance of Deuteronomy 6:4 = falsities of Matt 24 in reference to the improper interpretation of "Echad" as well as Elohim = plural.

It can also be confirmed that the Shahada without the controversy of the lettering does bring in 7N since it has been stated by Japhet that Islam are righteous and agree with 7Ns who advocate the oneness of God.

This is the missing component of that particular controversy. The Law comes out of Jerusalem city and the Shahada are in total agreement except for the Prophet which is not confessed by Japhet. From

the occult perspective - Asshur would agree with the Blackstone and knows that its Saturn.

Take careful note that the **Dajjal** is presented as a Messiah in opposition to **Isa Ibn Maryam** and he is followed by Japhet and by women as well as Turks and Persians.

King of the South and the Dajjal

In [Daniel 11](#) the King of the North = 7th king of Rev 17 and he

"shall come against him [King of the South] like a whirlwind" but "comes to his end and none shall help him.

Just as is stated in [Rev 17:10](#)

¹⁰And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space.

Fact is the [Grand Monarch](#) of the RCC prophesies is brutal against King of the South. But it's the 7th King who suffers the deadly wound prior to the 1260 days of Rev 13.

In other words, the two monotheistic "church state" rivals Islam and RCC are both doctrinally weakened – to the point the scarlet woman and her great city is

destroyed. And the King of the South has suffered a major defeat. See Dan 11:40-44.

Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon escape = [Dan 11:41](#) and the great city of the scarlet woman is destroyed.

The only monotheistic structure still standing is Judaism and from where arises the 8th king the false messianic = that wicked one of 2 Thes 2. The AC. This is the time frame of the First Beast and the 1260 days.

These events of Dan 11 and Rev 17 are ALL prior to the Loud Cry of the First Angel. For those who can picture the consolidation of Scriptural events as of Dan 11:40-45 and then the Loud Cry occurs the lesson is that the folk in Islam realise they had been deceived by the **DAJJAL**, the guy with the wonky one eye.

God does not wish the children of Islam to be lost = Jn 3:16 but all to be saved - hence the call of the Loud Cry to come out of all the matrixes of Babylon the Great. Then it would be known Paul had the correct revelation in 2Thes2.

Those who disagree at this point - here is your question – why does God say in Rev 13 all the world worship the B? All = no exclusion! Right?

In other words, this fact exposes the thinnest and weakest theological issues of monotheisms 1 god theology.

For reasons yet to become known the King of the South of Dan 11:40-45 gets played – it could be over a bad business deal or its premature advice of the lying Dajjal. Either way or both, it doesn't matter.

Daniel foretold what is to happen and it has to be consistent with the First Angels Warning. The 1 god is the big banana in the fruit shop of monotheism and everyone is prepped by the Dragon to float their own canoes. And Unity Consciousness brings in the mystical ethereal.

There is no question the Quran and the respective hadiths are saying 1 God. There is no debate about this because it is encapsulated in the Nicene, the Shahada, and the Shema of Judaism.

It is that the **Hadith of Isa ibn Maryam** is clearly the weakest link of the Dajjal theology in Islam that cannot answer the First Angel let alone John 1.

The other fact is there is likely to be genuine contenders in Islam who change their allegiances to the real Isa Bn Maryam and to be sealed within the 144K of Rev 7.

The Loud Cry is to all and includes who are within Islam and at the time of the Loud Cry it follows a decision must be made about the Two Divines of John 1 especially when destruction of the King of the South and the King of the North arises.

Why? there is a permanent ancestry affiliation back to Abraham.

Fact is no one has this viewpoint about the Dajjal from perspective of John 1. This is the greatest challenge to the entire problem of monotheism problem - otherwise why would Isa ibn Maryam who destroys the Dajjal ever need to be mentioned?
