



Certain things only apply to a woman that is led by the spirit and the spirit leads to maturity. Or then a woman from the world that can perceive a **high value man** = maturity. Yet there are 'gangsters' as well as high value men.

Sometimes the two function together in a symbiosis in worldly terms and woman crave the looks, the money, but they don't get a lot of attention from this type of man yet the fact that he can keep them at bay and not get entangled and defeated by falling in love is one of the traits that women desire.

Yet this does not necessarily define the traits of a high value man since these men don't get married and might be of a narcissistic character that is perceived to be of high value yet not so from the Biblical perspective.

Whereas in the spiritual realm **King David** appears to be the example since he was a man who functioned well and was comfortable in his masculinity was a great warrior for the Lord and was never in trouble with woman up until the time that he saw Bathsheba. It appears that David knew a lot about women. He can be defined as an **Alpha male** and dearly loved his Saviour. This was reflected in his repentance in Psa 51.

### **Inner Purity:**

In this present day and age, men have to be like David minus the adultery.

From the time he was a youth especially watching over the sheep that is when the qualities of a high value man were being crafted and the pinnacle of that perfection came in the form of the slaying of Goliath a perfect Testimony for all to see in the heavens and on the earth.

Whatever one might say of Biblical characters David was probably the second greatest high value man on the Biblical scale since the **Throne of David** in which Jesus Christ will sit is named after him since Jesus is the offspring of David.

Yet the first High value man title would have to be given to **John the Baptist** who prepared the way for the Lord and he had to experience the excruciating factor of loneliness and did not deviate from his mission in any way shape or form.

That is why Jesus said that he was greatest yet a child in the Kingdom is greater than John the Baptist.

The pinnacle of the high value man can be expressed in terms as the innocence of a man child which in the heavenly perspective is greater than John the Baptist but from the practicality of living in this world then it is my belief that men of God have to be like David since they have to deal with woman as well as procreation.

Yet the apostle **Paul** had zeal and this particular zeal was a highly valued trait in the eyes of HWM which was being used for evil and after his conversion I believe that the apostle Paul became a high value man considering that HWM used him for bringing the knowledge of the Gospel to the gentiles.

### Similar to David but weak:

Another case in point was **Samson** who being one of God's **super soldiers** was not a high value man - since he led himself to be seduced by Delilah same as Adam yet in another form.

**King Ahab** another example of **Beta male** foolishness. Solomon was originally a high value man but was seduced by his foreign wives into idolatry and magic.

There are good women that are not led by the spirit of God and can see the value in certain men since it takes maturity and perhaps prior pain in order to see this.

A high value man may not necessarily be spiritual in the true sense as defined by scripture but would value the same traits that Jesus portrayed in his life. Courage, independence, career minded = carpentry, Holy aggression in reference to casting out the merchants from the temple, honesty in speaking the truth as well as determination to achieve or accomplish a certain goal or goals.

Revelation 19 presents the aggression of Jesus when he will come to destroy his enemies as well as the Kingly aspect of waging this war against the forces of evil which claim the title of the Davidic throne over planet earth. Yet a high value man in both the worldly sense and the spiritual tend to get things done and are practical in day-to-day life experiences.

A high value man knows how to conduct himself as a man and does not submit to the nonsense of woman and feminism in particular and won't cry if she decides to leave.

Same thing Jesus told his disciples, this is speaking of the 70 who first walked with Him.

Many left since they stated that his words were too difficult meaning the Jesus metaphorical use of eating his flesh and drinking his blood. These were actually the first Roman Catholics since they misinterpreted the metaphorical use of Jesus words.

#### What women admire:

Women admire a man that can stand up to them and who basically don't care about consequences and takes chances and is not too clingy or dependent on them emotionally and doesn't let them lead all the time. Fact is that this is where **Adam** messed up. He followed the woman when in fact he was created as a high value man.

**Eve** didn't have the maturity to follow her husband and she must have known what Adam was told by HWM. She was seduced by her inner nature which in itself was also a form of mystery of iniquity.

That is why Feminists and witches would consider Eve to be a high value woman in 2023.

Eve's looks, and perhaps her passion, probably caused Adam to fall deeply in love with her. Yes, her passion.

Fact is -she was willing to explore outside the confines of her known world which was the Garden as well as the intimacy of her husband and decided to enter into dialogue with the serpent, a third person.

This type of exploration is very prominent in the world of feminism and it's invading every country like never before. That is the problem of why there is now a movement which is growing which seeks the liberation of men from the domineering role of Western woman. Their desire is to fly off to other countries where they can meet foreign women who have not been infected with the sickness of feminism.

That is why guys who go to church are at times ignored by women who are immature and like the bad boy outside which will cause them pain in the long run. It doesn't mean that the man or young man is wrong.

Yet his conditioning inside the church has not taught him to compete with the men in the outside world and will be seen by his own sisters as perhaps weak or undesirable in comparison to those outside. It is that innocence which is pure which has to be protected.

The other way to see it is to wait on the Lord, yet even church men need to cultivate the jewels that are required of a high value man. The best Bible example of a high value man was King David. He would be considered the closest thing to a bad boy. David was a spiritual man but at the same time he was worldly and its likely he drove woman crazy.

#### Innocent men in church

He is actually pure and the nature of some church woman who might be immature is impure and not in alignment with how HWM sees the matter. Those who have gone through this experience in the church understand how the church girls cannot be trusted and are sometimes just as bad as the ones outside.

It's the wickedness of woman that craves that animal instinct of a man who will dominate them in the intelligent way. Here a low value man overcomes High value man. Fact is that role was fulfilled by Satan in reference to Eve since she followed his advice.

# The spiritual formation

The purity of high value man untouchable by seduction is aptly metaphor by HWM especially concerning Mystery B mother of H's. It's also the high value of the characteristics of patience and waiting on the Lord. David had deep insights and yet the bad boy image is strange for many to consider – but there was Bathsheba. Further, so many women stick to their crazy bad boy man. Yet hate it and are long disappointed but stand by their man.

What Jesus stated about the innocence of children and that a child is greater than John the Baptist in the Kingdom of God reveals two things -The innocence is a highly valued trait in the spiritual realm and Jesus was the Prime example of a high value man.

Yet somewhere it was stated be a subtle as serpents and guileless as Doves.

### Conclusion-

David in his simplicity and love for God fulfilled that manly aspect of what it means to be a true man of God who in reality sits on the throne at the right hand of Jesus as a David and that believers have to imitate the guileless character of Jesus while being innocent yet subtle as serpents since the "children of the world are wiser than the children of the light." Luke 16

It is this innocence that causes Christians to be abused by Muslims and others. While this is a good witness - Jesus also told his disciples to go out and buy a sword. Luke 22

It's kind of an awkward statement but like David perhaps we are not called to turn the cheek all the time.

The Messianic throne is a throne of warrior and conqueror and there is the possibility that Christians should not always turn the cheek under certain circumstances.

A case existed in which a black man was beating up a Methodist pastor and the pastor kept telling him that he was a Pastor and then all of a sudden, the man reacted and started crying considering that he had beaten up a man of God. Well, that is an excellent testimony of turning the cheek. But there are times that you may be called on to defend your family and are you going to be a weakling and let others abuse your family?

On another occasion - there was a Taxi driver close to the hotel that was saying bad things to the high

value man about his wife in relation to prostitution while crossing the street to enter the Hotel. Later when the high value guy went out of the Hotel with his mom and wife, The High value man confronted the guy outside who insulted his wife and was literally going to kick his posterior and he backed down and said sorry. The wife was proud and told a former co-worker. She was proud that her husband defended her.

There are times when we have to be like David. Many years later, a tall and strong tough guy told the high value man this was a foolish thing to do since the guy could have attacked the high value man with his friends. While that was a possibility the guy always worked in the hotel area as a Taxi driver and its likely he wouldn't risk his job like that since he was creating trouble for two guests that were staying in the Hotel.

## Closing statement.

Innocence is the high value trait that can be accomplished in the Kingdom of God since a child is greater than John the Baptist. "Blessed are the pure in heart for they shall see God".

But innocence in the world of sin while being a beautiful trait has to be protected and that is why the admonition to be as subtle as serpents and guileless as Doves implies the recognition of how the world operates and that includes the knowledge of all its traps, vices and schemes.

Yet in the real-world innocence will be seen as impractical and weak and putting oneself in a dangerous situation since danger or malice or hypocrisy might not be perceived yet Jesus was able to perceive it.

Some will say that we were not made for the world that we live in. Having witnessed this statement in the lives of two people that I have known. Yet in reality this happens all the time. The world of adulthood changes people and that includes most people in the world and in the churches. This statement has many levels.

Worldly women do not like innocent men and if they do it is to corrupt their nature and they will enjoy that. Then there are women who may have experienced corruption and they may see an innocent man in all his purity and would want that man for themselves.

The ideal situation for a Christian would be the paring of an innocent man along with an innocent woman same as in the Garden of Eden.

The moral of this story is that the concept of a high value man in Biblical terms appears to be very different from that of the worlds concept which includes financial independence a knowledge of how the world functions, knowledge of the opposite sex especially in intimate matters along with a healthy dose of subtle narcissism that can be perceived by women.

Whereas King David was masculine as well as a warrior whose character was cultivated by God working in the field as a Shepard boy who would one day lead Israel on the Davidic throne.

An individual once said that he had a dream that he was stomping on a little chickadee and then a voice said don't do that. Some might perceive this as a literal event yet when I heard it, I understood its clear implications. Don't lose that innocence that you had or have. It was clearly the transition from childhood to adulthood.

# **Lastly – King David**

David deeply repented in fearfulness Psa 51.
